Ocala Horse Sale Consignor Letter:

We will start checking in horses on Friday around 10:00am until 5pm. Please make sure you bring all <u>original</u> paperwork including registration papers, signed transfers, health certificate(for out of state horses) & Coggins dated within 1 year (you MUST have your original coggins. This is your yellow handwritten copy OR a COLOR vet link document.) NO OTHER DOCUMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED including copies of yellow's & you CANNOT show your coggins on your phone. The name & age listed on your coggins must match your consignment information. If you have changed your horses name you should have a new coggins pulled or ensure that is the barn name you use in your description.

*This is a state of Florida requirement. If you arrive without accepted coggins you will be unable to sell your horse. We suggest checking in early in case an emergency coggins draw is necessary. Even better, we suggest you ENSURE you have the proper coggins before arrival. The Ocala Horse Sale is not responsible for horses turned away by the state check in, no refunds will be given and any outstanding charges will remain due.

Check in table will be located inside the barn, across from the office. All horses must be checked in by the state before running through the auction. Please let us know if you will not be arriving until Saturday, check in is 8:00-10:30 am Saturday. **Horses turned away for incorrect coggins by the state will forfeit consignment fee & any additional sale fees.**

We invite all horses to get settled on Friday! We have a lot of potential buyer traffic on Friday and we try to offer competitions & demonstrations for you to show off your horse. Preferred horses MUST attend & demonstrate on Friday for the Pref demo.

Once you arrive you will find a stall chart list posted in the barn, across from the office. Here, you can find your horse by **Lot #** order and assigned stall. The pavilion provides 1 bag of shavings per stall but will have additional for purchase at the office. You can also bring your own shavings as that will be the most cost effective for you. We recommend bringing your own wheelbarrow & fork.

Please prepare to supply a water bucket, hay / feed for your horse for its entire stay. You are responsible for the care of your horse from arrival until leaving the facility. **All sellers must ensure their horse has ample water at all times.** Once you sell your horse the new owner takes responsibility for care. HOWEVER, you MUST give your horse adequate care <u>prior</u> to leaving. We suggest bringing an old bucket you can leave so your horse has water upon your departure as many buyers stay through the end of the sale. Failure to care for your horse in a reasonable manner will BAN you from future consignments.

Stall price is included in your consignment starting Friday. If you plan on arriving before Friday, please contact Scotty Campbell at 903-724-4776 so arrangements may be made, price is \$30 per day prior to Friday, no exceptions! TACK STALLS (when available) are \$50 and will be limited to requesting consignors with multiple horses. If you're interested please email us ASAP. They are first come, first serve and may not be available at all pending numbers. If you wish to stall with a trainer or friend please email us to be stalled together, otherwise you will NOT be near one another.

RV hook ups are available for \$55 per **DAY**. To reserve, you must pay in advance on our website or by contacting Courtney @ 716-725-7950 / <u>ocalahorsesaleoffice@gmail.com</u>. The Ocala Horse Sale does not have a host hotel. We mainly use the AVID in Ocala, but mention the horsemens rate at any Ocala hotel for possible discounted pricing.
